The Agency on Aging of South Central Connecticut Can help with your “switch to digital”

The Agency on Aging of South Central Connecticut is offering a free service to help seniors and individuals with disabilities make the switch to Digital Television (that is taking place on June 12) simple and successful. Although there has been a lot of publicity concerning the switch to digital, there has been a lack of free “hands on” personal assistance to help people make the change, until now.

Here is a list of what the Agency on Aging can assist you with:

- Assess the need for a converter box. This can be done over the phone or in person.
- Assist in obtaining a \$40 coupon off the price of the converter box. (Please note there is a maximum of two coupons per household).
- Arrange for pick-up and delivery of the converter box.
- Arrange for a trained volunteer to visit the residence and install the converter box.
- Train the user how to properly utilize the new technology.
- Follow up with any problems that may occur.
